## Payment Plan

### Setting up a payment plan:

- Go to MorganCC.edu
- Log into MyMCC
- Select the “Financial Aid & Payments” tab
- Under Payment Options, click on “Sign up for NBS Payment Plan”

### Payment plan benefits:

- Easy online enrollment
- Broken into smaller payments
- No interest

### Payment methods:

- Automatic bank payment (ACH)
- Credit card/debit card

### Cost to Participate:

\$35 enrollment fee per semester  
(\$30 fee for non-sufficient funds)

### Fall/spring semester payments:

1/3 down payment when you enroll, remaining balance is paid as follows:

**Fall** – 2 payments in Oct & Nov

**Spring** – 2 payments in Mar & Apr


### Summer semester payments:
