

2021-2022 Colorado Career and Technical Education (CTE) Grant Application Instructions

Please note that certain eligibility requirements must be met before you can be considered for funding. First-time recipients will receive priority consideration. Funding is provided by the Colorado General Assembly.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The following must be true:

- 1. You are a Colorado resident for tuition-paying purposes (you must be eligible to receive Colorado Opportunity Fund (COF).
- 2. Your program of study is a short-certificate program(s) approved by a governing board. CTE programs that have been approved by the US Department of Education for Title IV aid are not eligible.
- 3. You demonstrate financial need by providing documentation that you are currently eligible for <u>at least one</u> of the following:
 - A Pell-eligible Expected Family Contribution as demonstrated by the FAFSA;
 - A Pell-eligible Expected Family Contribution as demonstrated by the Income Form for ASSET Students only;
 - Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) Benefits;
 - Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Benefits;
 - Supplemental Security Income (SSI) or Disability Benefits;
 - Section 8 Housing Vouchers;
 - Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) Benefits;
 - An income that is eligible for Free and Reduced Lunch Benefits;
 - An income that is too low to require a Federal Income Tax Filing.
- 4. You are not receiving VA benefits or other outside sources such as WorkForce that cover program costs.
- 5. You are in good standing and demonstrate academic progress according to the institution's published policy of Standards of Satisfactory Academic Progress for financial aid purposes.
- 6. You have a high school diploma or recognized equivalent; you have not earned a bachelor's degree or higher.
- 7. You are registered with the Selective Service System, if required.
