## FAQ's Regarding Application to the PTA Program

# 1. If I haven not completed all of the admission requirements by the May 10<sup>th</sup> application deadline, should I still apply?

Yes, you should still apply. Due to recent circumstances, the program recognizes that some of the requirements are difficult to complete at this time. If you are missing any of the admission requirements, including the ATI TEAS test, the program will work with you on an individual basis in completing them after the May 10<sup>th</sup> deadline.

### 2. Will I be able to take the ATI TEAS prior to the May 10<sup>th</sup> application deadline?

Due to current closure of the MCC Testing Center as well as PSI Testing Centers nationwide, completion of the ATI TEAS test is not currently possible. At present, the MCC testing center is closed through April 26<sup>th</sup> and PSI Testing Centers are closed through April 30<sup>th</sup>.

Applicants should complete the ATI TEAS test as soon as possible once testing centers reopen.

### 3. How should I submit the application to the PTA program?

The program typically accepts the application via US Mail, but will also accept the application materials by email at <a href="mailto:Jeffrey.Coon@Morgancc.edu">Jeffrey.Coon@Morgancc.edu</a>

To submit the application electronically please scan all completed forms, including unofficial transcripts, save in pdf format, and submit as an email attachment. In the subject line, please include the term "PTA Application Materials."

To submit by US Mail, please utilize the address provided on the last page of the application.

### 4. Will any applications be accepted after the May 10<sup>th</sup> deadline?

The PTA program at Morgan Community College can accept up to 20 students each year. If the program does not receive applications from 20 qualified applicants at the May 10<sup>th</sup> deadline, we will accept applications on a rolling basis beginning May 11<sup>th</sup> until all 20 spots have been filled. Any qualified applicants that apply after maximum enrollment of 20 students has been met will be placed on a waiting list per program policy.

### 5. If I qualify for an interview based on my application, will this take place in person?

Interviews are currently scheduled to take place the MCC campus during the first week of June for all applicants that qualify. Additional interviews may be conducted over the summer for students applying after the May 10<sup>th</sup> deadline. Given the current

circumstances, a web-based interview will be scheduled for applicants that would prefer this method. More information on this process will be provided to all applicants invited to interview.
