

PTA Program Financial Responsibilities

Program Costs, Tuition and Fees

Morgan Community College is part of the Colorado Community College System. Students who are Colorado residents may be eligible for participation in the College Opportunity Fund (COF). COF is not a need based financial aid, but a subsidy from the State of Colorado for the education of its residents. The costs for the PTA program at Morgan Community College for 2024-2025 are estimated to be \$179.06 per credit for in-state tuition and fees and \$688.76 per credit for out-of-state tuition and fees. Online course tuition and fees are \$278.20 for in-state and \$419.75 for out-of-state. As a resident, if you opt out of the COF stipend, an additional \$116.00 per credit hour is applied. Additional fees may be attached to specific courses and will be reflected in the total of each semester bill. *Tuition and fees are based on prior year and may be subject to change.

Total costs for completing the program including fees, textbooks, immunizations, etc. will vary by student. depending on total number of credits taken to complete the program. An accurate estimate may be obtained by meeting with a program advisor prior to admission.

Student Housing

Morgan Community College is strictly a commuter campus and does not offer a student housing option.

Students are also responsible for all expenses associated with internships and must provide their own transportation to and from clinical internships. Housing arrangements during internships are the student's responsibility.
