FUNDING AVAILABILITY: Awards are not guaranteed and are based upon funding availability.

Federal Pell Grant

Eligible students who have received full-time Pell for fall and spring terms receive additional Pell Grant funding for the summer as long as they enroll half-time (6 credits) or more.

Students that were enrolled part-time for fall and/or spring can receive a maximum of their remaining Pell funding for the 20-21 academic year.

Other types of funding that may be offered:

Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (SEOG), Colorado Student Grant (CSG), Federal Stafford Loans (Subsidized and Unsubsidized), Federal PLUS Loan, institutional grants/scholarships, and MCC Foundation grants/scholarships.

CONDITIONS: To be eligible, you must meet all requirements for the specific fund type. Your aid eligibility will be prorated to reflect your actual enrollment status. Some types of financial aid require a minimum of 6 credit hours of enrollment.

Pell Grant funding is contingent upon a student's Lifetime Eligibility Used (LEU) status of <600%. Student loans are subject to academic yearly maximum amounts. Independent students: Freshmen - \$3500 in Subsidized/Unsubsidized base loan and \$6000 Additional Unsubsidized loan; Sophomore - \$4500 in Subsidized/Unsubsidized base loan and \$6000 Additional Unsubsidized loan; Dependent students follow above guidelines for base loan, but are only eligible for \$2000 in Additional Unsubsidized loan funds.
