Through on-site therapeutic intervention, case management, and peer support systems, the Sober Living Residential Program fosters a successful transition toward sober living while addressing the challenges that may hinder the client's continued success.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Peer support
- Two Residences: Women (with dependent children if needed), and Men's Residence
- Onsite addiction treatment and case management services
- Short term program lasting generally 3-6 months.
- This program is voluntary and residents may choose to discharge from the program at any time.
- Residents pay nominal program fees and participate in communal house duties
- Residents are employed, seeking employment, or pursuing education or training
